



## HEALTH SCREENING PROCEDURES & POLICIES

ALL students are subject to a health screening prior to entry to campus. In order to maintain the health and safety of each person on campus, it is vital to conduct health screenings. Each screening will consist of temperature and symptom checking. Students who present symptoms will be sent home. All teachers and staff are subject to the same restrictions. We appreciate your understanding of this new yet necessary procedure for drop-off.

Students will be asked if they have any of these symptoms:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Difficulty breathing
- Headache, muscle or body aches
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- New loss of taste or smell

Students will have their temperature checked with a forehead thermometer. **Any temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher is defined as a fever.**

If you develop any of the symptoms listed above, or any symptoms that are not on the list that concern you, contact your healthcare provider. It is recommended to get tested for COVID-19. Make a note of the day when the symptoms first began. Inform the school office at 818-894-3213 as soon as possible.

Any person, student or faculty member, on-campus presenting symptoms will be sent home immediately. In that event, online learning may continue at home, if your child's health permits.
